HERE'S SOME OF WHAT WE DO



We run **youth centres and outreach sessions** across York, with activities ranging from cookery to sport, from drama to dancing - and with staff who'll give you the support you need.



We deliver the **connexions** service, giving you personalised careers information, advice and guidance in school, college, work-based learning and community settings - and more intensive help if you need it.



There's **Castlegate**, the confidential information, advice, support and counselling service for young people aged 16-25, just behind Fenwick's in the city centre.

We operate the **Duke of Edinburgh's Award** for York, giving young people aged 14-24 the chance to learn new skills, help others and experience adventure.



We run **The Zoo** - one of the best and friendliest skate parks in the region.



We drive two **URBIE** minibuses - our mobile youth centres that go out and about across York bringing information, support and all sorts of activities into local communities.

We've got opportunities to get involved in drama, film, music and more, right in the middle of York at **The Basement** project.



We provide mentoring, support, activities and alternative learning programmes to young people who could benefit from it, through our **Network 2** services.

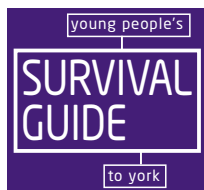
